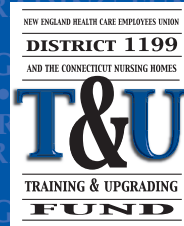


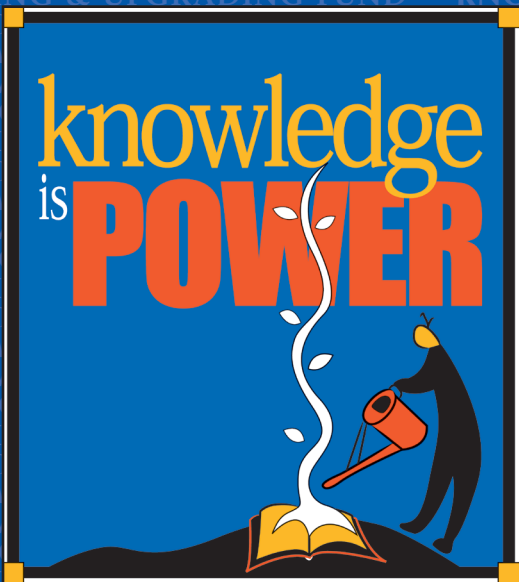

# your benefits

**Tuition Vouchers, if approved, pay tuition and fees up to \$2,500 per semester for semester-based college courses.**

**NOTE:** Textbooks are not covered by vouchers. You may be reimbursed for 50% of textbook costs after each semester.

## IF YOUR VOUCHER IS APPROVED:

- Submit the voucher to the college.
- Submit copies of registration documents to the Training Fund.
- Attend classes and earn a grade of C or better. \*
- Maintain contact with the Training Fund's College and Career Counselor during each semester.
- Submit end of semester documents.

# your future

**ELIGIBILITY:** You must have continuously worked at least one year for a participating employer by the application deadline in order to be eligible. You must have worked an average of at least eight hours per week during the previous year. Some CBA's require that part-time employees must have worked an average of at least 20 hours to become a Fund participant.

**A new application and appointment are required each semester.**

## APPLICATION PERIODS:

- Spring Semester:  
October 1-December 15
- Summer Semester: April 1-May 31
- Fall Semester: June 1-August 20

**LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

### \* YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO REIMBURSE THE TRAINING FUND IF:

- You receive a grade of C- or less, including "W" (or other withdraw grade)
- You do not average at least eight hours per week (20 hours if required by your Collective Bargaining Agreement) during the semester
- You are awarded grants or scholarships during the semester
